## MGT 346 Course information:

### Practice EOC operations in a large-scale incident!

This 3-day course allows participants to practice EOC operations in a large-scale incident coached by instructors who have emergency management experience and who provide this training nationally. They will use multi-agency coordination responsibilities, processes, and procedures and focus on key information management, resources coordination and situational awareness requirements within the EOC. The participants gain practical experience (virtual) within a state-of-the-art training environment that utilizes the ever increasing capabilities of computer simulation. Each participant will gain a better understanding of the management requirements and skills necessary to effectively function as a member of an EOC during a large-scale event.



## Target Audience:

Participants should have emergency management duties at any level from the local jurisdiction to the state, or have duties in an EOC during times of crisis.
